

## The Lieutenant Colonel D. Zerell Hall Leadership Scholarship

This award was established by Lieutenant Colonel Hall, who is a native of Blythewood, SC, and graduated from the last class of Bethel-Hanberry Middle School in 1990. He concluded his high school career as the Student Body President of Spring Valley High School in 1994. After he received his commission in the United States Air Force in 1999 from Air Force ROTC, Detachment 775, University of South Carolina, he began to serve his country as a Second Lieutenant. While on active duty, Lieutenant Colonel Hall has functioned for the Line of the Air Force as a Security Forces and Protocol officer. During 2006, he transitioned to the Medical Services Corps; in the medical administration role he has completed various flight commander roles at the 4th Medical Group, Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, North Carolina. Following that assignment, he performed as a medical fellow for the Headquarters Air Force Strategic Plans and Programs Directorate, Pentagon, Virginia; which led to an assignment to the Office of the Air Force Surgeon General, Medical Programming Division, Falls Church, Virginia. Lieutenant Colonel Hall has deployed to Al Udeid Air Base, Qatar and Kabul, Afghanistan. He serves as the Administrator, 6th Medical Group, MacDill Air Force Base, Florida.
