

The Education Foundation Arts Scholarship

To be awarded to a worthy senior student supported by reference from an Arts Teacher. Applicant must have at least a 3.0 GPA and have contributed through service to BHS and/or the greater community. The applicant must complete the Foundation general application and write a brief essay (2 typed pages) addressing one of the following questions appropriate to his/her arts area:

Essay question:

Visual arts: Provide a critique of one or two of your art pieces that you have created. You may address how and why you chose the subject matter and materials that you used. Please provide a photograph/scan of the art piece(s).

Dance, theater, chorus, music: Many people are quite surprised to learn how many rehearsal hours it takes to deliver a first-rate performance. As a performing artist, from where or from whom do you draw your inspiration and motivation to pursue excellence in your field? Discuss why you chose the particular arts discipline(s) that you have pursued at BHS.

Optional: Submit or include a link to a video or audio file that showcases your performance in dance, theater, chorus, or music.

Creative Writing: Submit a creative writing sample of your choice. (limit 2 pages, please) Please note any awards won for creative writing.
